Rules & Regulations

*All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at www.agshowsnsw.org.au. Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows.

Indemnity and Waiver Forms: The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Bribbaree Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed & signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. Any spectator entering the arena must complete this form.

Horse Health Declaration: All competitors must also complete a Horse Health Declaration, <u>each horse</u> with which the competitor has bought onto the Showgrounds <u>must be listed</u> together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.

Refusal of Entry/Alteration of Schedule/Prizes: The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the schedule to meet emerging circumstances. The Society is not responsible for the non-delivery of Sponsor's trophies/prizes. Should there be any reason to suspect that any exhibit is either diseased or dangerous, the Society reserves the right to isolate, refuse entry to and/or remove the exhibit from the ground at the expense of the exhibitor.

- All horse entries are taken on the day. Office located near the horse entrance to main arena and open from
- Number System All Competitors MUST register and receive a number card for every horse competing. Numbers must be presented to stewards in the ring, no number no details no performance recorded.
- ¥ All Ring events run under ASC rules
- ¥ All riders are required to wear approved helmets and footwear at all times whilst on the showgrounds
- **▼** Show Hunters and Show Hacks
 - At the beginning of each calendar year an exhibitor MUST choose the category for their exhibit, EITHER Show Hunter or Show Hack, when competing at an AgShows NSW Affiliated Agricultural Show or supplementary event.
- Judges: The judge's decision is final. No protests will be allowed
- Age of riders: Is actual age on day of the event
- ¥ Age of horses: Is calculated at 1st August
- Stallions & Colts (one year & over): Must be shown bitted. Stallions and Colts may only compete in classes where specifically permitted & exhibited/handled by a person 17 years and over They must wear a green disc at all times to identify them as a stallion or colt
- Champion: Only those winning first place in eligible classes are to parade for Champion
- Reserve Champion: Exhibits placed second to the Champion are eligible for judging for Reserve Champion.
- All Champion & Reserve Champion winners in round one are not eligible for round two classes
- Horses in appropriate classes must be registered with their Breed Societies and copies of Registration must be available for presentation. Owners must be financial members and membership cards must be available
- First Season: Open to all horses who haven't competed under saddle in any discipline (racing excepted), prior to the 1st January this year. They must be shown in a snaffle bit
- "Local" means within 20 km Radius of Bribbaree or a Member of Bribbaree Pony Club
- In the event of two classes clashing, competitor is to choose which class to enter. Rings will NOT be held for any competitor, unless the ring co-ordinator/master allow. In this case the exhibit will be allowed to join the end of the line up.
- No refunds for tickets, ground entry, stalls or camping
- The committee reserves the right to alter the schedule at any time and accepts no responsibility for any errors or omissions.
- Improper Behaviour will not be permitted. Offender names will be submitted to the ASC I Bribbaree Show Society Inc retains the right to test horses for prohibitive substances
