RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All horse entries are taken on the day. Office located near the horse entrance to main arena and open from 8am.
- **Number System** - All Competitors MUST register and receive a number card for every horse competing. Numbers must be presented to stewards in the ring, no number no details no performance recorded.
- **All Ring events run under ASC rules All riders are required to always wear approved helmets and footwear whilst on the showgrounds.**
- **Show Hunters and Show Hacks** • At the beginning of each calendar year an exhibitor MUST choose the category for their exhibit, EITHER Show Hunter or Show Hack, when competing at an Ag Shows NSW Affiliated Agricultural Show or supplementary event.
- **Judges:** The judge's decision is final. No protests will be allowed
- **Age of riders:** Is actual age on day of the event
- **Age of horses:** Is calculated at 1st August Stallions & Colts (one year & over): Must be shown bitted. Stallions and Colts may only compete in classes where specifically permitted & exhibited/handled by a person 17 years and over They must wear a green disc at all times to identify them as a stallion or colt
- **Champion:** Only those winning first place in eligible classes are to parade for Champion
- **Reserve Champion:** Exhibits placed second to the Champion are eligible for judging for Reserve Champion.
- **All Champion & Reserve Champion winners in round one are not eligible for round two classes** Horses in appropriate classes must be registered with their Breed Societies and copies of Registration must be available for presentation. Owners must be financial members and membership cards must be available
- **Newcomer:** Open to all horses who haven't competed under saddle in any discipline (racing excepted), prior to the 1st January this year. They must be shown in a snaffle bit
- **District:** means within 60 km Radius of Bribbaree

RULES AND REGULATIONS (continued)

- **Pony Club Classes:** Competitors must be a current member of Pony Club Australia
- **In the event of two classes clashing, competitor is to choose which class to enter.** Rings will NOT be held for any competitor, unless the ring co-ordinator allows. In this case the exhibit will be allowed to join the end of the line up.
- **No refunds for tickets, ground entry, stalls or camping**
- **The committee reserves the right to alter the schedule at any time and accepts no responsibility for any errors or omissions.**
- **Improper Behaviour will not be permitted. Offender names will be submitted to the ASC**
- **ASC retains the right to test horses for prohibitive substances.**
- All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at www.agshowsnsw.org.au.
- Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows. Indemnity and Waiver Forms: The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk.
- Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Bribbaree Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. Arm band will be issued when completed
- A similar form must also be completed & signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. Arm band will be issued when completed
- Any spectator entering the arena must complete this form. Arm band will be issued when completed.
- No arm band no entry into horse area.
- Horse Health Declaration: All competitors must also complete a Horse Health Declaration, each horse with which the competitor has brought onto the Showgrounds must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.
- Refusal of Entry/Alteration of Schedule/Prizes: The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the schedule to meet emerging circumstances.
- The Society is not responsible for the non-delivery of Sponsor's trophies/prizes. All prizemoney must be collected before 5pm Show Day at the Secretary's Office or your prizemoney will be donated back to the Bribbaree Show Society.
- Should there be any reason to suspect that any exhibit is either diseased or dangerous, the Society reserves the right to isolate, refuse entry to and/or remove the exhibit from the ground at the expense of the exhibitor.
- Any protests must be lodged in writing with the Secretary within half an hour of the event in question with a sum of \$50 attached. This sum may be forfeited if the protest is found to be frivolous or unproven.
- Any infringement of these regulations will disqualify the exhibitor from taking a prize.
- The committee reserves the right to reduce the prize money or cancel any event of competition's not forthcoming in any of the classes in this schedule. Where trophies are listed, there must be two or more exhibitors before trophy is competitive.
- The committee will not be held responsible for injuries, loss or damage to exhibits, exhibitors or personnel.
- Judges may award a second prize in lieu of first or may withhold altogether any prize money when there is only one exhibitor or when the exhibits are considered not worthy.
- All persons who, after entering their exhibits (stock in particular), are unable to exhibit should notify the Secretary at least three days before the Show to assist the stewards to make other arrangements
